AIFS SUMMER ADVANTAGE

AIFS Summer Advantage programs provide high school students with the opportunity to study abroad before they enroll in college, strengthening their prospects for acceptance at a university through foreign language study or liberal arts courses abroad.

Students enroll in the Richmond International Summer Session in Nanjing, China; London or Cambridge University, England; The Sorbonne—University of Paris IV, France; Richmond in Rome, Italy; St. Petersburg State Polytechnic University, Russia or at the University of Salamanca, Spain. Students must be at least 16 years of age (17 for Salamanca), in good academic standing and have completed their sophomore year of high school (junior year for Salamanca).



AIFS Summer Advantage provides a unique opportunity for students to experience an educational program in a college setting and get a head start on one or more of the subjects they wish to study in college. Students who apply to college in the autumn of their senior year will be able to submit the transcript and grades from this program along with their high school record, thereby enhancing chances for admission. Such applicants will be more interesting candidates and may well find the college they attend will give them advanced standing or transfer credit based on the transcripts and grades of their summer program.
